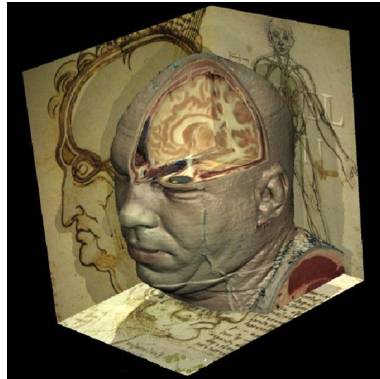

- An overview of Cognitive rehabilitation approaches
- Goal setting and strategies for executive function
- Rehabilitation for memory including prospective memory
- Treatment for inattention
- Impact of motivation/engagement and emotional adjustment on cognitive rehabilitation.
- Visual perception terminology and incidents of impairments
- OT assessment for visual perception and praxis
- Intervention strategies for apraxia and unilateral neglect.
- Current research in OT assessment and intervention for perception and praxis.

Speaker Profiles:

Dr. Jennifer Fleming OT, Assoc. Professor in OT at University of QLD and Princess Alexandra Hospital. Dr. Fleming completed her PhD in 1996 and has been an active researcher since then focusing on psychosocial aspects of brain injury rehabilitation and outcomes with a particular focus on cognitive rehabilitation, She has published her work in over 80 publications to date including journal articles, book chapters and a textbook. Her presentation on cognition will include assessment and management strategies, case studies, goal setting and research findings on the following topics: metacognition/self-awareness, executive functions, learning and behavioural techniques, memory and attention, motivational and emotional issues, and community re-engagement and reintegration

Deirdre Cooke (OT, PHD) Rehabilitation Coordinator for the Mater Private hospital Rehabilitation Unit in Brisbane. Ms. Cooke also lectures in Occupational Therapy at the University of Queensland. Her areas of clinical specialty and research include neurological rehabilitation following stroke, acquired brain injury, and Parkinson's Disease. Ms. Cooke was also involved in the development of the Occupational Therapy Adult Perceptual Screening Test (OT-APST), which also formed the basis of her PhD thesis. Ms. Cooke has had numerous articles published and co-authored an OT text chapter on cognitive assessment. Her presentation on visual perception, unilateral neglect, and praxis will include terminology, assessment, intervention strategies and outcome measures. There will be client videos for discussion of clinical scenarios, and clinical problem solving for complex client presentations.
