

Nationalisation Update – July

Towards a single professional organisation for Occupational Therapy in Australia



There have been no further developments throughout June regarding the proposed move to a single national entity. Key steps in the transition process awaiting finalisation are:

1. Distribution of a detailed Business Plan for the proposed new National Organisation. National Office anticipate the Business Plan will be ready for distribution by end June 2008.
2. Further modifications to the Constitution of OT Australia Ltd.

Once these steps are completed, NSW members, along with all members nationally, will be asked to vote on the transfer of assets to OT Australia Ltd (the new National organisation).
